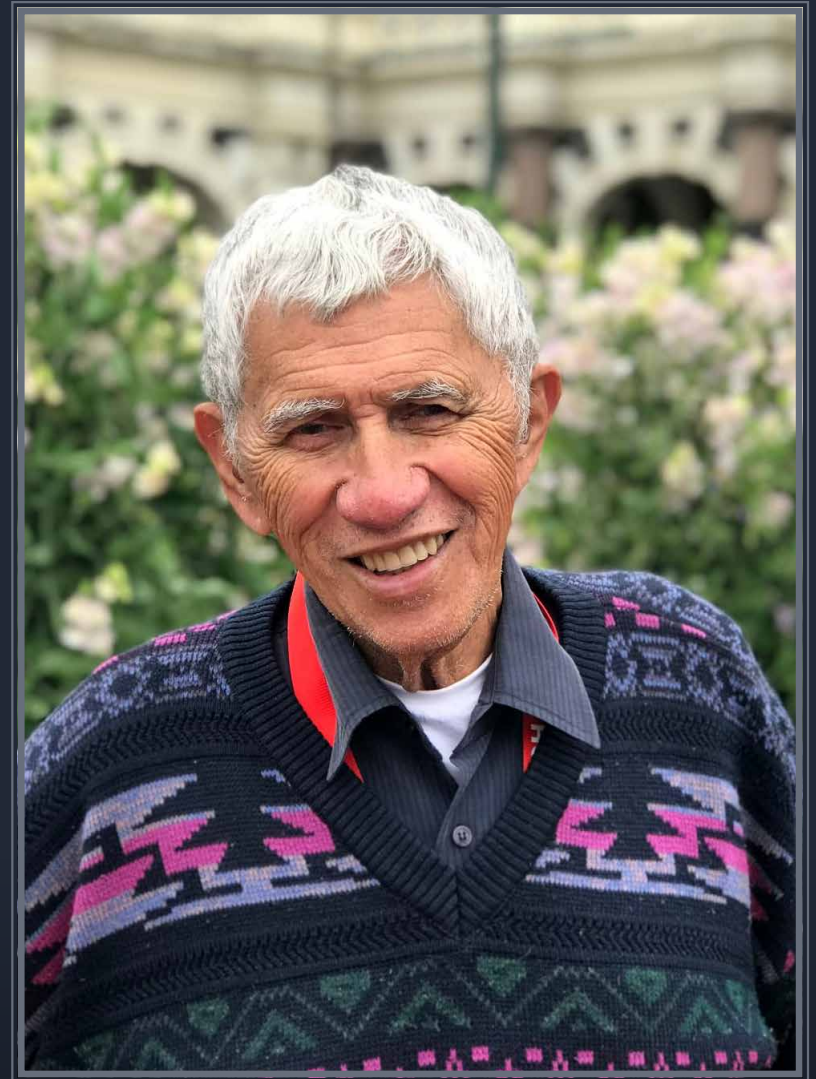
The family thank you for your love and prayerful support here today.
